
Detailed dataset of >3.5K patients with hospitalised Primary Biliary Cholangitis (March 2000 to January 2024). Granular care pathways. Deeply phenotyped. Serial physiology, blood markers. Demography, investigations, treatments and outcomes.

Demographic

The dataset includes:

- Children & young adult **2%** (ages 0-20)
- Adults **58%** (ages 21-65)
- Elderly **40%** (ages 66+)

Based on the index of multiple deprivation map, **26%** of the population are from most deprived areas and 13% of patients are from least deprived areas.



Total of **332** Liver transplant operations completed and over **1K** liver related medical procedures recorded.

Inpatient care

- **7,156 Hospitalised spells;** containing **3,520** patients with diagnosed and presumed PBC
- 83K days worth of hospital data with an average in-hospital length of stay of 11 days
- In-hospital mortality rate of 5% and 95% of patients surviving within 30 days from admission The median Early Warning Score (EWS/NEWS2) is 1 and the median AVPU Scale is 4
