Other Updates:

 This quarter the Data Trust Committee has been discussing improvements that we could make to the request process. The aim is to give requestors clearer guidance around what we expect to see on a Data Request Form. They have also provided ideas for how we can support the Data Trust Committee to review the forms.



- Suggestions include asking data requestors for an 'elevator pitch' type summary, either written or recorded as a short video clip to introduce the importance of their project to the DTC. We are also looking into creating a checklist for Data Trust Committee members to complete when they are doing the pre-reading, helping them come to meetings better prepared to discuss each request.
- For requestors we are in the process of creating a user-friendly guide to completing the Data Request Form. This will detail what the Data Trust Committee are looking for to support their recommendations, as well as an explanation of what the technical and information governance teams will need to see in order to process the request.
